As a reminder, all faithful Catholics must attend the Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Attendance at the Liturgy means more than showing up in Church. Attending the Divine Liturgy means active participation, by following the prayers, saying the responses and listening attentively to the readings of the Epistle, Gospel and the homily.

The Divine Liturgy is a sacred moment and we have to participate from its beginning to the very end. We should be spending some time in prayer before the Liturgy starts (at least 15 minutes), and staying to the very end, when the priest closes the Royal Doors. We should then make a prayer of Thanksgiving (for 15 minutes) and we all depart Church together.

Please, take a moment this Lent to spend more time in prayer, especially during the Divine Liturgy by participating fully from the beginning to the end! Remember, please do not talk in church, be respectful of others in prayer. The church is a place for prayer and quite reflection.
