Lenten Journey - 2017



Christians throughout the world are entering Lent, the season of Christianity where people fast for 40 days (excluding Sundays). The 'sign of penitence' that lasts for the whole season starts on Monday and ends on Holy Saturday - the day before Easter Sunday.

The season is widely understood and accepted to be a period of meditation, fasting, repentance and reflection on one's deeds and many exercises encapsulating various disciplines are undertaken by Christians as a reflection on life, the words and sacrifices of Lord Jesus Christ.

Lent is a time to renew wherever we are in that process that I call the divine therapy. It's a time to look what our instinctual needs are, look at what the dynamics of our unconscious are. "Lent comes providentially to reawaken us, to shake us from our lethargy." - Pope Francis.

"Renounce yourself in order to follow Christ; discipline your body; do not pamper yourself, but love fasting." -- Saint Benedict.

There is no way we can arrive to Easter Sunday if we do not live the agonies of all our Good Fridays. There is no way we can achieve eternal life with God unless we deny ourselves utterly and totally in Christ. This we do when we endure and sustain our own personal crosses and follow Him.

These gifts we must seek the only moral way – through prayer and inner struggle. If you would be first in our Lord's estimation, you must imitate, not the rulers of this world, but the humble spirit of the Master Himself, who told us, "I have not come to be ministered unto, but to serve".

Amen, and God help us faithfully follow Jesus', on the path of our new life of holiness...
