“Phillips Fast - Pylypivka is the pre-Christmas fast which begins Thursday, November 16th – the day after the feast of St. Philip. It is a 40 days period of spiritual preparation for the celebration of the Nativity/Theophany cycle of the church year. It was once a period of strict fasting, which has now been abrogated in favor of voluntary fasting and works of penance.” (Sower - October 29, 2017 Issue)
